Religious Accommodations

Wor-Wic Community College recognizes the rich and diverse backgrounds of its students and is committed to making reasonable accommodations for the observance of sincerely held faith-based or religious beliefs, or for a student to participate in organized religious activities.

Since religious observances or activities do not always conform to holidays on the academic calendar, a student is allowed reasonable, alternative accommodations for missing an exam or other academic requirement, provided the student notifies their instructor in advance. The college does not impose a penalty for excused absences, a student missing an exam or other academic requirement as permitted in this policy.

Faculty must be sensitive to the religious practices of students and provide appropriate alternatives. If a faculty member refuses to make accommodations for religious observances or activities, the student should follow the Discrimination and Harassment Policy.

The college also provides a space on campus to accommodate faith-based or religious practices. Henson Hall Room 101 (HH 101) is set aside for this purpose.
