## Grading Scale

Students are required to attain at least a 75% average in theory and at least a 75% average in the clinical laboratory. Students must attain at least a 75% total calculated average on all exams, quizzes and/or standardized assessment tests (ATI), whether they are counted in the theory or clinical averages (as applicable) for the following courses: NUR 101, NUR 111, NUR 115, NUR 121, NUR 216, NUR 221, NUR 222, NUR 223, and NUR 260. Grades are not rounded. Failure to attain at least a 75% average in theory, clinical laboratory, or as a total calculated average on all exams, quizzes and/or standardized assessment tests will result in failure of the course and dismissal from the Nursing Program.
