Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate with an Associate of Applied Science degree, students must obtain a grade of “C” or better in all pre-requisite and radiologic technology courses, and a grade of “D” or better in ENG 151. Students must also meet all clinical objectives and maintain current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certification while enrolled in the program. Students are required to satisfactorily complete all programmatic and American Registry of Radiologic Technologists® (ARRT®) clinical competencies.

Individuals who successfully complete the Radiologic Technology Program can take a certification examination in radiography administered by the ARRT®. After passing the examination, program graduates are certified to work as Radiologic Technologists. State certification as a medical radiation technologist is required for employment in Maryland.
