The Tactical De-Escalation Training course is designed to equip law enforcement professionals with advanced skills and strategies for managing crisis situations effectively. Participants will learn the principles of crisis intervention, de-escalation communication, threat assessment, and tactical decision-making in scenarios involving edged weapons, blunt instruments, and firearms.

Throughout this course, participants will engage in interactive lectures, practical exercises, and roleplay scenarios to enhance their understanding and application of key concepts. The course curriculum covers a range of topics, including de-escalation communication techniques, threat assessment and management, interacting with individuals with developmental disabilities, tactical decision making, and crisis intervention scenarios.

By the end of the course, participants will be proficient in assessing and managing crisis situations, employing de-escalation techniques, adapting communication for individuals with developmental disabilities, and making sound tactical decisions while prioritizing the safety of themselves and others.
